

ENGLAND WADO-KAI KARATE-DO RENMEI (EWKR) CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the policy of EWKR that all our students, instructors, officials, parents and volunteers show a mutual respect and understanding for each other. Everyone should be treated equally within the context of the training environment and conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the principles of EWKR. The aim is for all participants to enjoy their karate training and to continue to improve their performance at their own set pace.

We will <u>not</u> tolerate abusive language, swearing, aggressive and intimidating behaviour, lack of respect to others and their property.

Instructors/Officials/Volunteers

- · Consider the welfare and safety of students
- · Promote good techniques and training and follow the EWKR training syllabus
- · Ensure activities are appropriate to age, ability and experience of those taking part
- · Build relationships based on mutual trust and respect
- Avoid unnecessary physical contact with young people (also see our Safeguarding Policy)
- · Be a role model and display consistent high standards of behaviour and appearance
- · Communicate clearly with parents and students
- · Be aware of any relevant medical information of the students
- Follow all EWKR policies (Safeguarding Policy and Privacy Policy)
- · Use social media responsibly when posting about karate

Students

- · Listen and accept what you are asked to do to improve your performance
- · Respect other students, instructors, officials and volunteers
- · Abide by the EWKR rules and train to the best of your ability
- · Take care of all property belonging to other participants, the club or its members
- · Use social media responsibly when posting about karate

Parents

- · Encourage and support your child
- · Encourage your child to accept responsibility for their own conduct and performance
- · Respect the instructors opinions
- · Provide emergency contact details to club instructors
- · Inform the club or organisers of any relevant medical information regarding your child
- · Ensure your child wears suitable clothing and brings a drink with them
- · Use social media responsibly when posting about karate
